Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2015-16 educational progress for John Page Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. During the 2015-16 school year, the Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-Step) was administered for the second time. This assessment replaced the Michigan Educational Assessment Program (MEAP), which was used to track student growth for over four decades.

State law required that we also report additional information:

**1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL**

Students who live within the Lamphere School District are eligible to attend John Page Middle School. Additionally, Schools of Choice students from within Oakland County are accepted on a limited basis during a defined window.

**2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN**

The departmental staff of John Page Middle School identifies goals each school year. Relevant goals and objectives are written and continuously implemented and monitored. The school improvement process is the focus of many of our professional development conversations.

**3. A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL**

John Page Middle School is home to the middle school Cognitively Impaired (CI), Emotionally Impaired (EI), and Autistic (ASD) classrooms for the Lamphere District. We are fortunate to learn with and from our CI, EI, and AST students.

**4. CORE CURRICULUM**

Lamphere's core curriculum is currently housed in Atlas and includes all core academic areas. The curriculum is reviewed and adjusted on a frequent basis.

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### **5. LOCAL ASSESSMENTS**

All students at John Page Middle School participate in quarterly assessments of their reading, math and writing levels. In reading and math students are assessed using the STAR Assessment. In Writing, students participate in collaboratively scored writing prompts.

### **6. IDENTIFY THE NUMBER AND PERCENT OF STUDENTS REPRESENTED BY PARENTS AT PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES**

John Page Middle School has an involved parent community. More than 65% of our students were represented by their parents at conferences for the 2016-17 school year.
